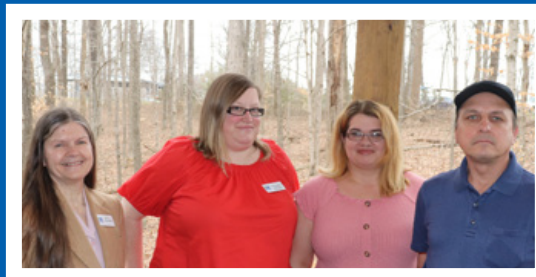

The \$485K gift will cover the costs of improving the camp's water supply infrastructure, improvements to the kitchen ventilation system, and provide funding for the miniature golf course scheduled to open in June.

This program was made possible this year through the generous support of Zak and Cassie Boca.

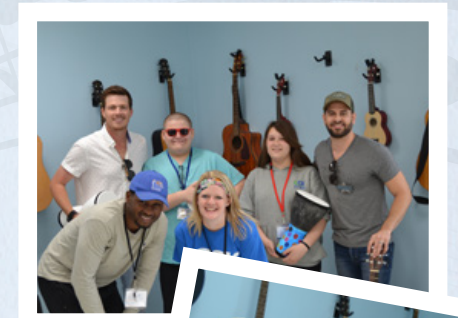


Music Therapy

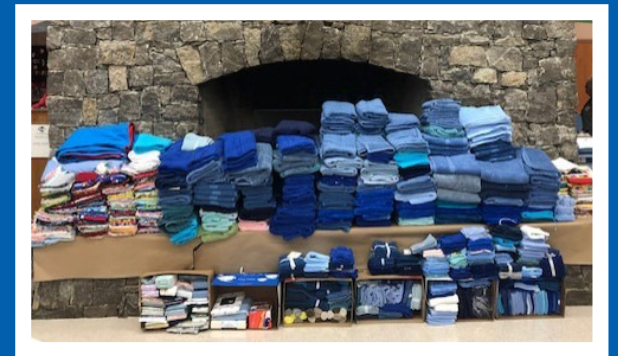


ENJOY *Retirement*, NANCY!

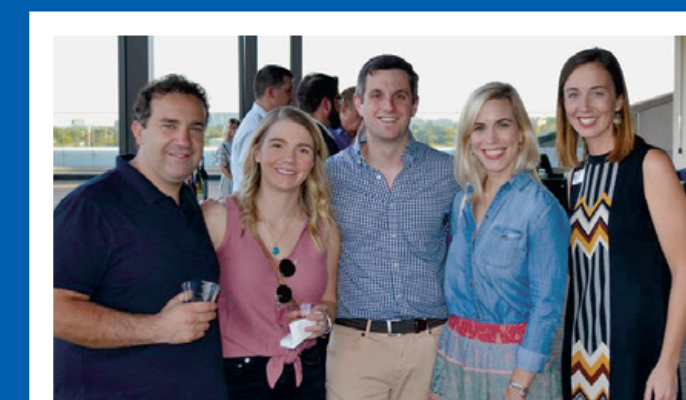


BMI EVENT IN NASHVILLE CREATES NEW Friends FOR CCK
