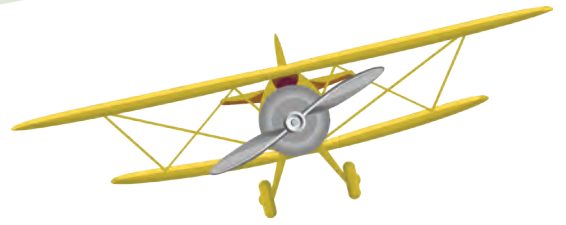

- Planting Confidence through Shared Experiences

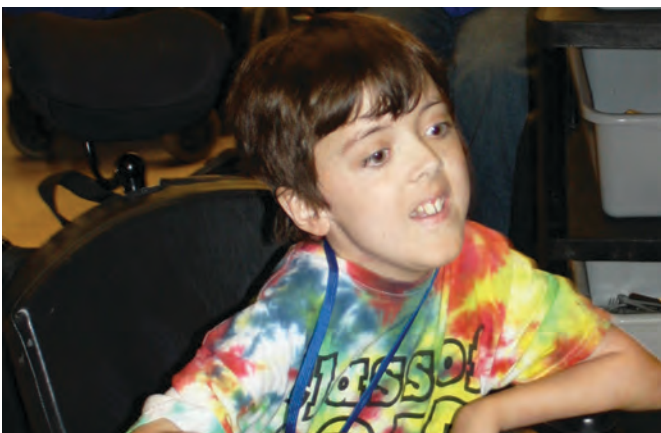

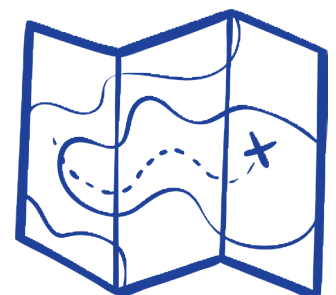

ACCESSIBILITY TAKEN TO THE NEXT LEVEL

One significant enhancement that changed the way we offer waterfront programming was the boat dock upgrade that happened before the summer season started in 2022. Just 13 days before the start of summer, the addition of a hydraulic lift system provided by Lyons Company increased our flotation weight capacity for an even more stable dock surface and improved our ability to keep campers comfortable when boarding the canoes.

Bluegrass Supply Chain graciously supported the addition of a dock-side Sure Hands hoist lift, maximizing CCK's accessibility standards at the lake-front. We are so grateful for the generous involvement of these amazing organizations.
